



**Colin Cooper** worked in Research Administration for over thirty-five years. His career started at Imperial College, leaving there to become Research Contracts Officer at City University London, then onto UMIST as Head of Research Administration. When UMIST merged with the Manchester University he became Head of Research Operations at the new University of Manchester, he then moved onto Liverpool University as Assistant Director of Research and then Director of Research. Colin then moved as Research Facilitator to Liverpool Hope University, a post he retired from in 2020.

Colin has been a member of the UK Research Councils Consultation Group and is SRA Distinguished Faculty (Emeritus). He has won a number of international awards including the Society of Research Administrators Hartford Nicholson Award for services to Research Management and a UK Administrator Fellowship. Colin was awarded the ARMA award for Outstanding Contribution to Research Management and Administration in July 2017, in the same year he received SRA's Herbert B. Chermiside Award for Distinguished Contribution to Research Administration.

Well known as a speaker for all the major Research Administration Societies, he has given a keynote addresses for ARMA, EARMA, ARMS and SRAI. He has worked as trainer for ARMA in the UK and SRAI in the USA. He was an initial founding member of International Network of Research Management Societies (INORMS) .
