## **EARMA Awards Committee: 2022 Awards Schedule**

**Background**: three members of the EARMA Awards Committee (AC) met on 10<sup>th</sup> January 2022 to discuss the drafting of an annual awards schedule for the coming calendar year. The purpose of this was to articulate a clear, publishable schedule of award calls replete with agreed operational processes to be deployed by the AC membership.

The full schedule of awards under the remit of the AC fall into two broad categories: (i) those of a fixed nature whose timing is dependent on preprogrammed events such as annual conference and (ii) those awards free of such dependencies that can be implemented at any time of year.

This approved version was published following the Awards Committee meeting on 7<sup>th</sup> June 2022.
