- It is an open community to discuss the practical and implementation side of Research Ethics and Integrity.
- ERION is closely working with the H2020 [SOPs4RI project](#) to promote institutional changes in research integrity for an effective implementation in research administration.



MEETINGS

- The community meets 2 to 4 times per year. In 2020, the size of the online events increased in number (from 2 to 4) and size (from 30-40 to more than 100 participants).
- There are around 250 members in the community.
- Members can exchange information through a web communication platform (SINAPSE) of the European Commission.
